Matthias Kawesi (56) is an air traffic controller at Entebbe International Airport and the Chairman and Chief Executive of ACODEF.



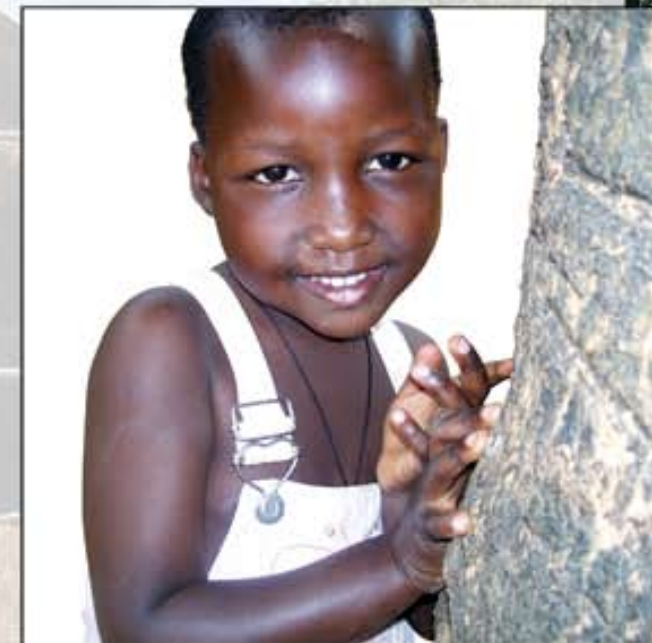
